BELIEVE

Think of a chair, when you sit in a chair you put all your weight on it. You trust that it will hold you up. That's what it's like to believe in or to trust in this gift. That's what it's like to believe in the gift of Jesus. To accept the gift that God gave you, you believe that God sent Jesus to die for you so that you can have a relationship with him.

BE BAPTIZED

We **commit** our lives to Jesus and follow his example by being baptized.

"As soon as Jesus was baptized, he came up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened. Jesus saw the Spirit of God coming down on him like a dove." Matthew 3:16 NIV

We follow the example set by the First Church in Acts 2.

"Peter replied, "All of you must turn away from your sins and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then your sins will be forgiven. You will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." Acts 2:38 NIV

"Those who accepted his message were baptized. About 3,000 people joined the believers that day." Acts 2:41 NIV

"After hearing this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus." Acts 19:5 NIV

Baptism is a picture of Christ Jesus' Death, Burial & Resurrection.

"By being baptized, we were buried with Christ into his death. Christ has been raised from the dead by the Father's glory. And like Christ we also can live a new life." Romans 6:4 NIV
